THE HAWKS

→ Saint Joseph's posted a 92-82 win at Princeton on Wednesday night as **Lamarr Kimble** scored 22 points, all in the second half while backcourt mate **Jared Bynum** had 19 points and six assists. **Taylor Funk** scored 16 points, **Charlie Brown, Jr.**, scored 11 points before leaving the game with an ankle injury, and **Markell Lodge** had a season-high nine points

→ **Charlie Brown, Jr.**, the leading scorer in the A-10 (22.0), is questionable for today after he sprained his right ankle on Wednesday night at Princeton. He will be a game-day decision and if he can't go, **Chris Clover** will start in his place

→ Saint Joseph's ranks second in the nation in turnovers per game, with an average of 8.1. Virginia is the leader with 7.9 turnovers per game. **Jared Bynum** leads the conference and ranks 10th in the nation in assist/turnover ratio with 4.4

→ The Hawks lead the A-10 in three-point percentage, converting 39.5 percent, and hold the top two individual spots with **Charlie Brown, Jr.** (52.0) and **Jared Bynum** (50.0)

→ Freshman **Jared Bynum** was named the A-10 Rookie of the Week after averaging 20.0 points last week

→ The Hawks get a two-week break for final exams before returning to action on December 22 by hosting Loyola Chicago at the Palestra

- Villanova has won six in a row and nine of the last 11 meetings versus the Hawks
- SJU's last win came in 2011 at Hagan Arena, 74-58, as current Detroit Piston Langston Galloway scored 20 points
- Saint Joseph's has a six-game losing streak at The Pavilion, with its last win here coming on Feb. 2, 2004. The 3rd-ranked Hawks were led by 22 points apiece from Jameer Nelson and Delonte West. That was SJU's 19th consecutive win in what would be a 27-0 regular season

LAST TIME OUT

- **Lamarr Kimble** scored 22 points, all in the second half, to lead Saint Joseph's to a 92-82 win at Princeton on Wednesday
- **Jared Bynum** had 19 points and six assists, while **Taylor Funk** scored 16 points. **Charlie Brown, Jr.**, scored 11 points before leaving the game with an ankle injury and **Markell Lodge** came off the bench to record a season-high nine points
- After halftime, the Hawks broke open a 39-36 game, even though Brown left the contest at 18:56. Kimble picked it up from there, scoring 10 of 13 points, to help SJU increase its lead to 53-45. Consecutive threes by Funk and Kimble gave the Hawks their biggest lead of the game, 63-47, at 12:55
- The Tigers outscored the Hawks, 13-4, to pull within 67-60 and then cut the deficit to 72-66, with 6:03 remaining. A dunk by Lodge started a 5-0 run that gave SJU a 77-67 lead
- **Chris Clover** helped seal the win, scoring six points in the final two minutes, including a 4-for-4 effort from the foul line

INJURY REPORT

- Leading scorer **Charlie Brown, Jr.**, is questionable for today's game with a sprained ankle suffered early in the second half at Princeton. His status will be determined prior to the game
- Top rebounder **Pierfrancesco Oliva** missed the Princeton game after suffering a concussion against Temple. He will sit out the Villanova game

WELCOME TO THE LEAGUE

- **Jared Bynum** was named the A-10 Rookie of the Week after averaging 20.0 points, 3.5 rebounds and 3.5 assists in the Hawks' 1-1 week for the first honor of his career
- He converted 68.8 percent (11-for-16) from the field and 94.1 percent (16-of-17) from the foul line in the two games
- Bynum tied his career-high with 17 points in the win over UIC, converting 9-of-9 free throws. He also registered two assists and no turnovers for the fourth time in seven games
- He then set a new career-high with 23 points against Temple, making 7-of-9 field goals and 7-of-8 free throws, and tying his season-high with five assists

FRESH APPROACH

- **Lamarr "Fresh" Kimble** helped the Hawks pull away at Princeton as he poured in 22 second-half points after **Charlie Brown** left the game with an injury early in the half
- The captain made 8-of-12 from the field in the half, and had 10 of 13 points as SJU expanded on a three-point halftime lead, going up by 53-45

- It was the second game in which Kimble had a big second half to help the Hawks to the win; he previously scored 24 of his career-high-tying 31 points vs. UIC in the second half
- Kimble is now averaging a career-best 18.0 points per game and is the Hawks' leader in free throw percentage with 80.9 percent

30 FOR 30

- SJU received individual 30-point efforts in three consecutive games, as **Lamarr Kimble** netted 31 vs. West Virginia and UIC while **Charlie Brown, Jr.**, had at 37 points at William & Mary

BYTES ON BYNUM

- **Jared Bynum** has been impressive in the start of his career and is averaging 13.9 points and leading the team in assists with 3.9
- **Phil Martelli** said of the freshman, "He might be a freshman academically and socially, but he's a basketball player. He belongs in these games."

TAKING CARE OF THE BALL

- The Hawks are ranked second in the nation in turnovers per game (8.1) and are ninth in fewest number of turnovers with 73
- SJU has committed less than 11 turnovers in every game this season, with a low of six vs. Monmouth
- The Hawks had an uncharacteristic 10 turnovers at Princeton, with three quick ones at the game's start; it was the most since they had 11 against UCF
- Freshman **Jared Bynum** leads the A-10 in assist/turnover ratio with 4.4 and is ranked 15th in the nation. He has 35 assists this year to just eight turnovers

WHAT BROWN CAN DO FOR YOU

- **Charlie Brown, Jr.**, established a new career-high for the third time this year as he poured in 37 points at William & Mary
- He scored 23 in the first half, the highest single-half total of his career, hitting 11-of-17 from the field and 11-of-14 from the foul line

- His 37 points are the third most in the history of Kaplan Arena and tied the seventh highest single-game scoring total in SJU history
- Brown is the leading scorer in the A-10 with his 22.0 average. The last Hawk to average 20+ points in a full season was Jameer Nelson (20.6) in 2003-04. Shavar Newkirk averaged 20.3 ppg in 2016-17, but he played only 12 games due to a knee injury

THREES ALL AROUND

- The Hawks have some of the top long-range shooters in the Atlantic 10 as **Charlie Brown, Jr.**, (52.0) and **Jared Bynum** (50.) rank one-two in 3-point percentage
- Brown also ranks second in the A-10 in three-point field goals made per game (2.9) while **Taylor Funk** is sixth (2.3)
- Saint Joseph's leads the A-10 in team three-point percentage, converting 39.5 percent
- SJU has made 90 threes, which is the 24th highest total in the NCAA

LIFT FROM LODGE

- **Markell Lodge** gave the Hawks a lift at Princeton, recording season-highs of nine points and 14 minutes
- Lodge had three dunks in the game, including one to start a 5-0 run with under six minutes to play, which helped seal the win

KEY TO THE CITY

- The Hawks are 0-1 in the Big 5 after last week's loss to Temple; SJU went 1-3 in the City Series last year
- Saint Joseph's has won 20 Big 5 titles (9 outright/11 shared), which is behind Temple's 27 titles (6/21 shared) and Villanova's 26 (15 outright/11 shared)

SJU VS. THE TOP 25

- The Hawks are 2-6 against ranked teams since the 2015-16 season, counting this year
- SJU's last win over a Top 25 squad came on February 27, 2018 at Rhode Island when the Hawks posted a dominating 78-48 win over the #17 Rams
- That was Saint Joseph's first win over a ranked opponent in a true road game since Jan. 2, 1979, when the Hawks defeated #15 Georgetown, 37-36, at McDonough Arena
- The Hawks faced #8 West Virginia this year in Myrtle Beach and suffered a 97-90 loss

20/20

- **Charlie Brown, Jr.** has tallied 20-plus points in five of nine games this season; he now has six games of 20 points or more in 40 career games

TAYLOR'S THREE'S

- Sophomore **Taylor Funk** has 105 three-pointers in the 41 games of his career thus far, which is the quickest to 100 of any Hawk. By comparison, all-time leader Langston Galloway made 75 threes in his first 37 games
- Funk set the SJU freshman record last season when he made 84 in 32 games
- He hit a career-best 6-for-7 from beyond the arc in the win over Wake Forest

IRON MEN

- Backcourt mates **Lamarr Kimble** and **Jared Bynum** are already racking up the minutes
- Kimble is averaging 35.1 to rank fourth in the A-10, while Bynum is right behind him at 34.9 minutes per game
- **Charlie Brown** was averaging 33.4 heading into the Princeton game but he only played 21 minutes due to the ankle injury

ON BOARD

- **Pierfrancesco Oliva** is the Hawks' leading rebounder with 8.0 per game
- He has grabbed double-figure rebounds in four of seven games, including the last two at William & Mary (12) and vs. UIC (13)
- Oliva posted the first double-double of his career in the opener vs. ODU (17 pts, 14 reb)

PRODUCTIVE 20 MINUTES

- **Lamarr Kimble's** 22-point second half at Princeton was his second 20-plus point half of the year, and the third highest of the season
- Kimble had 24 points in the second half against UIC which is highest single-half total for a Hawk this season. **Charlie Brown** scored 23 of his 37 points vs. William & Mary in the first half

SHARP SHOOTERS

- The Hawks have shot 50 percent or better in seven of 18 halves played this year, with a high of 58.6 percent in the second half of the Monmouth win
- SJU converted more than 50 percent in both halves at Princeton, finishing the game hitting 55.0 percent

DEPTH CHARGES

- The Hawks have not gotten much scoring from their bench this season and it has been a big factor in the four losses, as SJU's reserves have been outscored 123-20 in those games
- Here's the bench scoring breakdown:

END TO END

- The win at Princeton was the first game this season that the Hawks held the lead from start to finish. There were two ties, but SJU never let the Tigers forge ahead

HANDOUTS

- Saint Joseph's showed great ball movement against Wake Forest and got everyone involved as the Hawks had 20 assists on 32 baskets

RALLY TOWELS

- SJU trailed by 13 points in the second half against UIC on Wednesday, but rallied to post an 89-75 win; it was the largest deficit overcome for victory thus far this season

SLIPPING AWAY

- The loss to Temple marked the second double-digit lead lost by the Hawks this year
- They led the Owls by 11 with 3:29 to play in the first half but suffered the 77-70 loss
- At William & Mary, SJU held a 20-point lead at 18:38 of the second half but saw the Tribe rally to the 87-85 win

CHECK IT OUT

- **Pierfrancesco "Checco" Oliva** had a stellar season debut, coming off the bench to record the first double-double of his career against ODU
- The redshirt junior had 17 points and 14 rebounds, while shooting 6-of-9 from the field
- **Phil Martelli** said that although he doesn't like labels, "Oliva is the epitome of a point-forward". The coach also revealed that Oliva deferred his starting role to sophomore **Anthony Longpré**

YOU'RE A GOOD MAN, CHARLIE BROWN

- **Charlie Brown, Jr.**, was named the Atlantic 10 Player of the Week for Nov. 19, marking the first time he has earned the league's weekly honor as an upperclassman; he was also chosen as the Big 5 Co-Player of the Week
- He averaged 23.3 points in four games, shooting 58.5 percent from the field and 54.2 percent from three-point range (18-for-22)

CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN

- Redshirt junior **Lamarr "Fresh" Kimble** was voted team captain for the third consecutive season, becoming the only player in SJU history to serve as captain for three years
- As a sophomore, Kimble became just the third player in Hawk history to be named a captain in his second season
- Kimble's leadership is appreciated by **Phil Martelli**: "I'm glad he's on my team and I'm glad he's in my program because whatever I need... He's in charge of that locker room... Fresh is just legit. He's one of those guys that embraces being a Philadelphian and playing in Philadelphia.... I'm a big Fresh fan, forget the basketball. He is the epitome of a captain."

HAWKS HELPING OTHERS

- The Hawks will take part in their 24th annual Christmas Charity project over the coming week where they will provide gifts and a Christmas dinner to a few needy families in West Philadelphia, as identified by SJU's Campus Ministry
- The players will choose and wrap the gifts for their assigned families and then deliver them
- The project is aided from donations made by Saint Joseph's fans

WORKING FOR A CAUSE

- **Phil Martelli** and Jay Wright are heavily involved in the Philadelphia Coaches vs. Cancer effort, which is one of the nation's highest fundraising groups for Coaches vs. Cancer. The group, which is comprised of the city's six Division I coaches and their wives, has raised over \$14 million
- Martelli is the co-chair of the local group and is also the chair of the National Coaches vs. Cancer Council

LOOK AT LORENZO

- **Phil Martelli** stated in the preseason that redshirt sophomore **Lorenzo Edwards** was one player who had made the biggest strides over the summer
- Edwards gave a glimpse of that improvement as he scored 11 points in 15 minutes vs. Monmouth, making 5-of-7 from the field

WELCOME WAGON

- Graduate transfer **Troy Holston** made his SJU debut against Wake Forest
- Holston battled knee injuries through his time at South Florida, which caused him to miss two full seasons
- He has seen limited action in six games this season but made his first three-pointer as a Hawk at Princeton

PICKING THE HAWKS

- Saint Joseph's is picked second in the A-10 Preseason Poll, which is the highest for the Hawks since the 2012-13, when they were tabbed first
- Last year's squad was picked third in the poll, and despite two key injuries, finished fourth in the league and reached the semifinals while posting a 16-16 overall record
- **Lamarr Kimble** and **Charlie Brown, Jr.**, were each named to the 2018-19 Atlantic 10 Preseason All-Conference Third Team

THEY'RE BACK

- Two of SJU's leading scorers from two seasons ago — **Lamarr Kimble** and **Charlie Brown, Jr.** — have made their return to the court this season
- Kimble, who averaged 15.5 points per game in 2016-17, reinjured his left foot in the 2017-18 opener and missed the rest of the year. Kimble originally suffered the fracture in February of 2017 which caused him to miss the final seven games of the year
- Brown never got his 2017-18 season underway as he fractured his left wrist in the preseason, underwent surgery and was sidelined for the year. As a freshman, Brown averaged 12.8 points per game to earn All-Rookie honors

RETURNING CAST

- Other key returnees this season are:
- **Taylor Funk** (So.) - Team's leading returning scorer from last season (11.8) and the leader in three-point field goals (84), setting a new SJU freshman record
- **Pierfrancesco Oliva** (R-Jr.) - Top rebounder with 6.8 average and 3.0 assists per game
- **Chris Clover** (Sr.) - Starter in 28 games last year, averaging a career-best 8.2 points
- **Anthony Longpré** (So.) - Played in all 32 games as a freshman

NEW TO THE FOLD

- The Hawks welcome three scholarship newcomers in **Jared Bynum** (Fr.), **Troy Holston** (Gr. transfer) and **Ryan Daly** (Jr. transfer)
- Bynum, a point guard from Georgetown Prep averaged over 17 points and six assists last year. He was the IAC Player of the Year and an All-Met selection
- Holston joins the Hawks from South Florida, where he played two seasons while battling knee injuries. Holston, who received his bachelor's degree last spring, averaged 9.7 points in 2016-17. He has two years of eligibility at SJU, effective immediately
- Daly comes "home" to SJU, transferring from Delaware. A native of nearby Ardmore, Pa., Daly scored 1,000 points in two seasons at Delaware and earned All-CAA honors twice. SJU connections run in his family as both of his parents are alums and his late grandfather, Jim Boyle, was the Hawks' head coach from 1981 to 1990. Daly will have two years of eligibility at SJU after sitting out this season
- Junior **Greg Smith** also joins the Hawks as a walk-on this year

SEEING RED

- SJU's roster is dotted with five players who have redshirted at least one season while on Hawk Hill. Although that number seems unusually high, it is actually tied for the fifth most in the nation. Four schools (CSU Bakersfield, Rider, UCF, Saint Mary's) lead with nine each while Colorado State, Florida Gulf Coast, Norfolk State and Wisconsin have eight redshirts on their active rosters
- Saint Joseph's redshirts are:
 - **Charlie Brown, Jr.** (R-So.) - missed the 2017-18 season with shoulder injury
 - **Lorenzo Edwards** (R-So.) - had shoulder surgery during this freshman year
 - **Lamarr Kimble** (R-Jr.) - reinjured his foot in the first game of 2017-18 and underwent surgery, missing all but one game
 - **Markell Lodge** (R-Sr.) - redshirted his first year to concentrate on academics
 - **Pierfrancesco Oliva** (R-Jr.) - sat out his sophomore season after having surgery to correct a chronic knee condition

DEAN OF COACHES

- **Phil Martelli** enters his 24th season as head coach and is the dean of the Atlantic 10's coaches. He owns an overall record of 435-313 and is SJU's all-time leader in victories
- Martelli owns a 212-164 record in Atlantic 10 play, which ranks second all-time and first among active coaches for conference wins
- Martelli is one of 25 active D-1 coaches who are their schools' all-time wins leaders

FROM THE START

- **Jared Bynum** became the sixth freshman in six years to be in the Hawks' starting lineup on opening day
- Previous freshman starters for SJU were: **Anthony Longpré** (2017-18), **Charlie Brown** (2016-17), **Pierfrancesco Oliva** (2015-16), James Demery (2014-15) and current Atlanta Hawk DeAndre' Bemby (2013-14)

WISE BEYOND THEIR YEARS

- **Phil Martelli** has commented that the Hawks are an "older" team this year with five players who have redshirted previous seasons, including one graduate student (**Troy Holston**)
- The average age of the Hawks' scholarship players is 21 years old
- **Markell Lodge** and **Troy Holston** are both 23, while **Pierfrancesco Oliva** and Lamarr Kimble are each 22 years old
- The following are the Hawks' "redshirts" with their respective seasons on campus:
 - **Markell Lodge** (5th)
 - **Pierfrancesco Oliva** (4th)
 - **Lamarr Kimble** (4th)
 - **Lorenzo Edwards** (3rd)
 - **Charlie Brown** (3rd)
- **Troy Holston** is in his first season at SJU after transferring from South Florida. He played two seasons with the Bulls while battling knee injuries
- Also waiting in the wings is transfer **Ryan Daly**, who played two years at Delaware and will be sitting out this season

STRONG FINISH

- Despite facing its second straight season with key injuries in 2017-18, the Hawks came on strong at the end of the year and finished with a 16-16 record
- SJU closed out the regular season winning three straight and six of its last seven to finish in fourth place with a 10-8 record
- The Hawks defeated George Mason in the A-10 Quarterfinals but were edged by top-seeded Rhode Island, 90-87, in the semifinals

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

- One of the highlights of the schedule will be a date with 2018 NCAA Final Four team Loyola Chicago on December 22 at the historic Palestra
- The Hawks will take on defending national champion Villanova on December 8 in the Wildcats' new Finneran Pavilion
- In addition to Villanova and Loyola Chicago, SJU has five opponents on its schedule which reached last year's NCAA Tournament - West Virginia, Davidson, St. Bonaventure, Penn and Rhode Island

THE INJURY PLAGUE

- Last season was the second consecutive in which the Hawks faced significant injuries to key players
- In 2017-18, **Lamarr Kimble** (foot) and **Charlie Brown, Jr.**, (wrist) were lost for the year. Kimble played in only the season opener and Brown was sidelined in the preseason
- The previous year saw four players miss time with injuries. They were, with games missed: Shavar Newkirk (19), **Pierfrancesco Oliva** (entire season), **Lorenzo Edwards** (all but one game) and **Lamarr Kimble** (7)

HONORING THE COACH

- The Hawks are wearing a patch on their uniforms with "McK" to honor former coach Jack McKinney, who passed away in September
- McKinney was head coach at Saint Joseph's for eight seasons, from 1966 to 1974. He compiled a 144-77 record and owns the third best all-time winning percentage (65.2 pct) among SJU coaches
- McKinney took the Hawks to postseason play five times in his eight years, which included four NCAA Tournament appearances
- He went on to coach in the NBA, although a serious accident cut short his season with the Lakers in 1979. He rebounded to earn NBA Coach of the Year honors with the Indiana Pacers in 1981

HAWKS IN THE NBA

- Saint Joseph's is represented in the NBA by two players:
 - Langston Galloway (Pistons) - was undrafted in 2014 but made the Knicks' squad as a free agent; played for the Pelicans and Kings before joining the Pistons in 2017-18
 - DeAndre' Bemby (Hawks) - 21st overall draft pick in 2016 by Atlanta, who was the 33rd SJU player to be drafted, and the sixth to be taken in the first round

FUTURE HAWKS

- Saint Joseph's signed two scholastic standouts to national letters of intent during the early signing period - Hakim Hart and Kenan Sarvan
- Hart, a 6-5, 190-pound, swingman from Roman Catholic High School in Philadelphia, averaged 15.1 points per game last season and earned All-Catholic League honors. He helped Roman win the 2018 Philadelphia Catholic League championship and the 2018 PIAA 6A State Championship
- Sarvan is a 6-9, 220-pound forward originally from Holland and currently attending Bishop Sullivan Catholic High School in Virginia Beach. As a junior, he averaged 14.6 points and 7.8 rebounds for the Crusaders, who went 14-12.

HOME AT HAGAN

- This marks the 10th season of the Hawks' home, Hagan Arena, after Alumni Memorial Fieldhouse underwent a renovation and expansion in 2008-09
- SJU is 84-44 at Hagan but owns an all-time record of 403-126 in 68 years on campus
- The Hawks went 10-3 at home in 2017-18 and are 3-1 this year

BACK TO BROOKLYN

- The Hawks are happy about the return to the Barclays Center for the A-10 Championship as the arena has been good to them in the past. Saint Joseph's last two Atlantic 10 titles have been won on that court, in 2014 and 2016

CRADLE OF COACHES

- The Saint Joseph's coaching connection is an impressive one. A total of seven SJU graduates have gone on to become head coaches in the NBA, and SJU is tied with Illinois for second on the list of universities with alums that have served as NBA head coaches. Indiana tops the list with 11 graduates.
- Here is the list of former Hawks who have held positions as NBA head coaches:

THE RIVALRY

The Saint Joseph's- Villanova rivalry is one of the most intense in college basketball as just 6.7 miles separates the two Big 5 schools that are rich in basketball tradition.



Here's a look at some of the most memorable games in the series history:

- **Dec. 1, '15:** DeAndre' Bembry led five SJU players in double figures with 17 before a capacity crowd at Hagan Arena.
- **Dec. 11, '12: VU 65-61:** Langston Galloway hit six three-pointers and scored 22 points, but Villanova used a 9-0 run at the end of the game to edge the Hawks in a game in which neither team led by more than five points.
- **Dec. 17, '11: SJU 74- VU 58:** SJU students postpone their semester break to provide a high-energy atmosphere at Hagan Arena, in the first time the rivals played on SJU's campus. Langston Galloway led the Hawks with 20 points.
- **Dec. 9, '09: #3 VU 97- SJU 89:** #3 Villanova held off Saint Joseph's in front of a sold-out crowd at the Palestra. The Hawks' Idris Hilliard had a near-perfect shooting night, going 5-for-5 and making 12-of-13 free throws for a career-high 22 points while Scottie Reynolds scored 20 for Villanova.
- **Dec. 11, '08: #15 VU 59- SJU 56:** The Hawks keep the Pavilion crowd quiet for most of the game but two Scottie Reynolds free throws at :05 and two Hawk turnovers end SJU's upset bid.
- **Feb. 8, '08; SJU 77- VU 55:** The Hawks snap their three-game losing streak against Villanova before a capacity and pro-SJU crowd at The Palestra.
- **Feb. 7, '06; #4 VU 71- SJU 58:** For only the fourth time in Big 5 history, two 3-0 teams play for the city title. SJU couldn't sustain its play from the first 20 minutes as VU comes on strong in the second half to win in the sold-out Palestra in the game that marks the 50th anniversary of the Big 5.
- **Feb. 2, '04; #3 SJU 74- VU 67:** Jameer Nelson and Delonte West combine for 44 points to lead the 3rd-ranked Hawks to their 19th straight win in the standing-room-only Pavilion.
- **Feb. 3, '03: SJU 92-75:** Hawks roll to a 40-9 lead en route to the win.
- **Dec. 11, '00; VU 78- SJU 75:** Michael Bradley has 20 pts, 10 rebs.
- **Dec. 18, '94; SJU 60- VU 57:** Dmitri Domani hits two late free throws to cap a Hawks' comeback.
- **Dec. 8, '90; VU 83- SJU 82:** Marc Dowdell hits two free throws at :05 and the Hawks' Richard Stewart makes a layup instead of taking a 3-pointer.
- **Dec. 12, '87: SJU 53- VU 52:** Ivan "Pick" Brown, who shoots 2-for-15 in the game, rebounds a missed free throw with :08 to go and drives upcourt, sinking a bank shot at the buzzer.
- **Feb. 19, '87; VU 88- SJU 87:** Double OT classic ending with missed shots by the Hawks' Bruiser Flint and Jack Concannon.
- **Feb. 19, '85; VU 47- SJU 44:** Controversial ending as Dwayne McClain hits a baseline jumper and free throw with :02 left.
- **Jan. 31, '82: SJU 84-VU 64:** Bryan Warrick scores 23 points while both teams are NCAA-bound.
- **Feb. 19, '77; VU 92- SJU 78:** 'Nova wins the first Big 5 game played away from the Palestra (at the Spectrum).
- **Jan. 27, '73: VU 79, SJU 72:** Double OT game where Ed Hastings and Tom Inglesby combined for 43 points.
- **Feb. 20, '71: VU 63- SJU 55:** Classic duel between Mike Bantom and Howard Porter.
- **Jan. 16, '66: SJU 71- VU 69:** In one of the most memorable shots in Hawk history, Steve Donches, who entered the game in the final minutes, hits the game-winning jumper at the buzzer.
- **Feb. 20, '65: SJU 69- VU 61:** A bomb scare overshadows the game.
- **Jan. 12, '63: VU 63- SJU 61:** Eric Erickson's layup at :04 wins it in OT.
- **Mar. 3, '62: VU 66- SJU 59:** Hubie White had 23 pts and 17 rebs.
- **Feb. 12, '58: SJU 86- VU 82:** Trailing 52-35, the Hawks rally to win in OT.
- **Dec. 14, '55: SJU 83- VU 70:** First-ever Big 5 game in front of 2,636 fans where Al Juliana came off the bench to score 22 points.

PHIL MARTELLI Head Coach 24th Season - 435-313

With the 2018-19 season marking his 24th as the head basketball coach at Saint Joseph's, **Phil Martelli** has built a program that is consistently one of the top in the conference, a perennial postseason participant and a key player on the national scene. In doing so, he has earned his place among the top coaches in the school's storied history and is one of the more respected coaches in the game.

Martelli is the Hawks' all-time leader in career victories with a mark of 435-313. Setting the school record for wins in a season (30) in 2004, Martelli has guided SJU to 20 or more victories nine times in his 23 previous seasons, which is the most for any Hawks' coach. His record of 212-164 in Atlantic 10 play is the most conference wins for any active coach and ranks second all-time in the league.

Martelli Highlights:

- He has taken SJU to the postseason in four of the last seven years, and 13 times in the 23 seasons previous to this one, while winning three Atlantic 10 Championships (1997, 2014, 2016)
- Martelli's 18 postseason wins (7 NCAA, 11 NIT) are the most in school history
- Despite injuries to two key players, his 2017-18 squad won seven of its last nine games, to finish fourth in the Atlantic 10 and reach the conference semifinals
- His 2015-16 team compiled a 28-8 record for the second-most victories for a Hawk team, won its second Atlantic 10 title in three seasons and advanced to the NCAA Second Round for the first time since 2004
- Four of his players have been named the Atlantic 10 Player of the Year, with the most recent being DeAndre' Bemby in 2015-16
- In 2013-14, his veteran team turned in one of the more memorable seasons in school history, adding another A-10 Championship to his résumé as SJU went 24-10 and reached the NCAA Tournament for the sixth time under Martelli, falling to eventual national champion Connecticut in overtime
- Seven players have reached the NBA, including first round draft picks DeAndre' Bemby (2016), Jameer Nelson (2004) and Delonte West (2004) and a second-round selection, Ahmad Nivins (2009). Dwayne Jones and Ronald Roberts, Jr. had NBA stints while undrafted free agent Langston Galloway earned All-Rookie Second Team honors with the New York Knicks in 2015. Galloway (Detroit) and Bemby (Atlanta) are currently playing in the NBA
- In 2003-04, he guided a squad that became the most compelling story in college basketball - the Hawks went undefeated in the regular season, were the top-ranked team in the nation and earned the school's first-ever number-one seed in the NCAA Tournament, advancing to the Elite Eight
- Joined with Jameer Nelson to sweep the National Coach and Player of the Year awards in 2004, marking one of the few times in history that the top player and coach were from the same school
- Current member of the NCAA Division I Basketball Oversight Committee; previously served the game as a Past President of the NABC's Board of Directors, and the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Ethics Coalition
- Is very involved with Coaches vs. Cancer, is the past chair of the National Council, and the co-chair of the Philadelphia chapter, which is one of the largest fundraising groups in this effort in the nation
- Was the co-recipient of the Circle of Honor Award given by the American Cancer Society in 2017, honored along with Temple's Fran Dunphy
- Has spent a total of 34 years with the Hawks' program, serving as an assistant coach for 10 years prior to attaining the top job in July, 1995

THE HAWK

One of the most famous mascots in college sports, the Saint Joseph's Hawk is in its 63rd year in 2018-19.

The Hawk is best known for staying in constant motion by flapping its wings throughout every basketball game and representing the Saint Joseph's motto, "The Hawk Will Never Die."

The idea for the Hawk as a mascot was originated by Jim Brennan during the 1954-55 season. Brennan, an ex-Marine and SJU cheerleader, at first wanted to secure an actual hawk, but later switched to the costume idea. The student government raised the 120 dollars needed to buy the initial costume, which Brennan donned for three years. He made his debut as the Hawk on January 4, 1956, a 69-56 win over La Salle at the Palestra. The Hawk has not missed a men's basketball game since that first season.

In addition to the constant flapping, the Hawk is also recognized by its "flying" in figure eights around the court during timeouts. The constant motion, coupled with the scrappy play of the University's athletic teams, helped to spawn the school's familiar slogan "The Hawk Will Never Die!" A few years ago, ESPN used a "flap-o-meter" on the national telecast of a Saint Joseph's game to estimate that the Hawk flaps its wings 3,500 times during a regulation game.

The Hawk is unique because it is one of the few mascots in the nation that travels to every game, and the student who holds the position gains a tuition scholarship. The student, who is selected through an interview process during the previous spring semester, also serves as a team manager for the men's basketball team and travels with the squad.

Domenic Godshall is serving as the Saint Joseph's University Hawk mascot for the 2018-19 season, becoming the 39th student to represent the University in this role. He is a senior sports marketing major from Lititz, Pa.



ON THE AIR

TV/VIDEO: Saint Joseph's fans will be able to watch all 31 men's basketball regular-season games either on television or through digital media. A total of 21 Hawks' games this season will be televised nationally while 10 will be streamed digitally. Nine games will appear on the subscription-based ESPN+.

It marks the second consecutive year of a partnership with the station. Also calling play-by-play on selected games for the second straight year is Pat McCarthy. (Schedule on pg. 2)

Through Hawks All-Access, fans can follow every home game through audio streaming, along with video features and highlights.

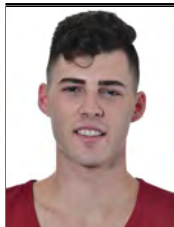

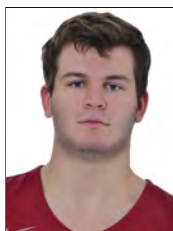
