### THE HAWKS

→ SJU snapped its four-game losing streak, and picked up its first A-10 win, by edging Davidson, 61-60, on Tuesday night. **Chris Clover** led the way with a season-high 18 points while **Jared Bynum** had 12 points and nine assists. **Troy Holston** had a season-high 11 points and **Charlie Brown** scored 11

→ Saint Joseph's suffered key losses in the Duquesne game with injuries to **Pierfrancesco Oliva** and **Lamarr Kimble**. Oliva is out for the year and Kimble will be sidelined indefinitely (more on pg. 3)

→ Saint Joseph's continues to rank second in the nation in turnovers per game, with an average of 9.4. Freshman **Jared Bynum** tops the conference and ranks 38th in the nation in assist/turnover ratio with 2.9 per game. Bynum has dished out 17 assists in the past two games

→ **Charlie Brown** is the leading scorer in the Atlantic 10, averaging 19.6 ppg

→ Tonight ends a stretch of 18 straight days of action for the Hawks, with six games, three road trips and practices mixed in between

→ This a Jesuit Basketball Spotlight game, which aims to raise awareness for Jesuit education (more on page 4)

• The Hawks have lost four of the last five against the Billkens, with the last win coming on Feb. 28 2016

• Saint Joseph's has one all-time win in Chaifetz Arena and it came in the first meeting between the schools, on Jan. 25, 2006. The Hawks are 1-6 here

**LAST TIME OUT**

• **Chris Clover** connected on a three-pointer at :59, and scored a season-high 18 points, to lead SJU to a 61-60 win over first-place Davidson and snap a four-game losing streak

• Davidson held a 60-58 lead at 2:00 until Clover's shot. The teams traded missed shots and free throws until Davidson had the ball at :26 and Kellan Grady missed on a jumper at :06. Davidson kept the ball and had two more shots in the final seconds but couldn't convert

• Clover shot 6-for-11 from the field and connected on a career-high four three-pointers. **Jared Bynum** scored 12 points and handed out a career-high nine assists. **Troy Holston** came off the bench to notch double figures for the first time as a Hawk with 11 points, including three threes, while **Charlie Brown, Jr.**, also added 11 points for SJU

• Saint Joseph's fell behind by seven, 42-35, early in the second half, but scored eight consecutive points, with threes from Brown and Clover, to go up, 43-42. After SJU upped it to 48-44 on a three by Holston, the teams traded leads and ties the rest of the way, with neither squad leading by more than two points

**LAST TIME VS. SAINT LOUIS**

• Davell Roby hit a free throw with 3.1 seconds to go to lift Saint Louis to a 60-59 win over Saint Joseph's on Jan. 31, 2018 at Hagan Arena. The Hawks had one last chance but couldn't get a shot off as time expired

• **Taylor Funk** scored 21 points, hitting 4-of-9 threes while Shavar Newkirk had 16 points

**CLOVER IN THE CLUTCH**

• Senior **Chris Clover** had his best game of the year when the Hawks needed it, against Davidson

• Starting in place of the injured **Lamarr Kimble**, Clover scored a season-high 18 points while hitting a personal best four three-pointers, including the eventual game winner with 59 seconds to play

• It marked the second straight game in double figures for Clover as he had 12 in the loss at Duquesne

• His previous season high was nine points

**THE INJURY PLAGUE**

• Saint Joseph's has certainly faced its share of significant injuries in three consecutive years with the current ones to **Pierfrancesco Oliva** and **Lamarr Kimble**

• Oliva will miss the rest of the season and Kimble will be sidelined indefinitely as both sustained injuries in the Hawks' loss at Duquesne on Jan. 12

• Oliva, a redshirt junior forward, dislocated his left knee in the first half of the game and has ligament damage. He will require surgery but

his rehabilitation timetable is unspecified

• Kimble, a redshirt junior guard, suffered a fracture in his right hand in Saturday's second half and will undergo further evaluation to determine whether surgery is necessary

• In 2017-18, Kimble (foot) and **Charlie Brown, Jr.**, (wrist) were lost for the year. Kimble played in only the season opener and Brown was sidelined in the preseason

• The previous year saw four players miss time with injuries. They were, with games missed: Shavar Newkirk (19), Oliva (entire season), **Lorenzo Edwards** (all but one game) and Kimble (7)

**NEXT MAN UP**

• With the Hawks facing the absence of two key players, **Phil Martelli** doesn't buy into the "next man up" theory, but it certainly seemed like the players did against Davidson

• Senior **Chris Clover** started in place of **Lamarr Kimble** and had his best game of the year with a season-high 18 points

• Graduate transfer **Troy Holston** had his first double-figure game with the Hawks, contributing 11 points, with three three-pointers, in a season-high 21 minutes

• Redshirt senior **Markell Lodge** tied his season-high in minutes (19) and contributed great energy while grabbing five rebounds and blocking two shots

**WELCOME BACK OFFENSE**

• After scoring 60 points or less in six straight games, the Hawks' offense got back to normal and tallied 84 in the loss at Duquesne

• The Hawks shot 47.6% from the field, the best effort since Dec. 5 when SJU scored 92 points at Princeton

• SJU has been outscored by 13.0 points in A-10 games and is shooting 37.0 percent from the field and 26.9 percent from three-point range in league contests

• The Hawks are now averaging 61.6 points in conference play, up from 54.3 ppg after the first three contests

**BYTES ON BYNUM**

• **Jared Bynum** has been impressive at the start of his career and is averaging 11.7 points and leading the team in assists with 4.1

• **Phil Martelli** said, "He might be a freshman academically and socially, but he's a basketball player. He belongs in these games."

• Bynum, who has scored double figures 10 times, had a career-high eight assists at Duquesne and bettered that with nine assists vs. Davidson

• He's also the A-10's leader in assist/turnover ratio with 2.9 as he averages 4.1 assists to 1.4 turnovers

**BROWN IS BACK**

- After matching a season-low with 11 points at St. Bonaventure, **Charlie Brown** scored 28 points at Duquesne
- The redshirt sophomore made 11-of-18 from the field and connected on four three-pointers, tying his season high

**SLOW START**

- SJU's 0-4 start in the A-10 matched the 2010-11 season when the Hawks went 0-8 to begin conference play. That team won four of its last six as it reached the semifinals of the A-10 Championship

**TO THE POINT**

- After scoring 70-plus points in eight of their first nine games, the Hawks averaged just 54.2 in six games from Dec. 8 to Jan. 9
- The low was 45 points vs. Loyola Chicago but thankfully, the Ramblers scored only 16 points in the first half and finished with 42 in the game, as SJU came away with the win
- The 45 points was SJU's lowest output since it scored 40 points against Charlotte on March 9, 2013
- Saint Joseph's scored 59 points in the win over Wagner, but did not have a basket in the final 4:53 of the game
- The Hawks also had a long scoreless streak in the final 10 minutes vs. George Mason, going without a point for close to six minutes as the Patriots went on a 19-0 run
- It was a similar scoring drought against GW, as the Colonials scored 13 straight points in the final five minutes of the game and closed it out with a 16-4 run
- The struggles continued at St. Bonaventure with one of the most lopsided first halves in recent memory. The Bonnies jumped out to a 17-1 lead and at halftime, led 39-12. Saint Joseph's lost the game, 73-47

**TAKING CARE OF THE BALL**

- SJU ranks second in the nation in turnovers per game (9.4) and second in fewest number of turnovers (159); Virginia is the NCAA's leader with 8.9
- SJU had a season-high 13 turnovers against both Loyola Chicago and George Mason
- The Hawks have committed 10-plus turnovers seven times this season, all occurring in eight of the last nine games. They matched their average with only eight vs. GW
- Freshman **Jared Bynum** leads the A-10 in assist/turnover ratio with 2.9 and is ranked 38th in the nation. He has 69 assists this year to just 24 turnovers
- Bynum notched eight assists at Duquesne, with just one turnover, and followed that with nine assists vs. Davidson

**RECOGNIZING HARD WORK**

- **Phil Martelli** announced that walk-ons **Mike Muggeo** and **Toliver Freeman** have both been awarded scholarships for the Spring semester
- Muggeo, a 6-3 senior guard, earned a spot on the squad as a walk-on in 2017-18, but was unavailable to play last year due to an injury
- Freeman is a 6-3 guard from Baton Rouge, La. (Catholic HS) who joined the Hawks as a walk-on in 2016-17. He has seen action in 10 games during his career, including four this season

**DOUBLING DOWN**

- **Charlie Brown** has scored double figures in 16 of 17 games this year, while **Lamarr Kimble** has hit double digits in 14
- Brown missed one game (Villanova) due to injury and Kimble did not hit double figures against UCF and GW

**HANDS OFF**

- As they have done the past few seasons, the Hawks have limited their fouls and rank ninth in the nation with fewest fouls (247)
- SJU ranks ninth in the NCAA in personal fouls per game with 14.5

**TWO SIDES OF THE BALL**

- Early on, **Phil Martelli** had been concerned about the Hawks' defense, as SJU was giving up 76.8 points per game through the first nine contests
- That seemed to be rectified as the Hawks allowed an average of 56 points in the three games (Villanova, Loyola, Wagner) leading up to the conference opener
- But that progress suffered a setback as Saint Joseph's saw George Mason score 85 points
- On the year, SJU's foes are now averaging 72.5 points per game

**JESUIT VS. JESUIT**

- Tonight's contest is a Jesuit Basketball Spotlight game as SJU and Saint Louis are both Jesuit universities
- The Jesuit Basketball Spotlight, which is in its eighth year, highlights games between men's and women's teams from the 28 Jesuit colleges and universities across the U.S. Other Jesuit schools on the Hawks' schedule are Fordham and Loyola Chicago

**NO TIME TO REST**

- Tonight's game concludes the Hawks' schedule of 18 straight days of either games or practice
- This stretch began on Jan. 1, giving SJU six games in the 18 days

- games (Dec. 8 and Dec. 22) and a week off over Christmas
- The new semester is underway with classes having resumed this past Monday

**COOLING OFF**

- The Hawks started the season as one of the better three-point shooting teams in the nation but have since cooled off
- SJU has made under 30 percent of its three-point attempts in six of the last 10 games
- The Hawks are converting 54-of-200 (27.0 percent) from behind the arc in the past seven games. The low point was a 0-for-13 effort in the first half at St. Bonaventure

**SLIPPING AWAY**

- The loss to GW marked the third double-digit lead lost by the Hawks this year
- SJU had a 12-point lead with 12:41 to go in the first half but saw GW turn in a big second half en route to the 70-56 win
- Against Temple they led by 11 with 3:29 to play in the first half but suffered the 77-70 loss
- At William & Mary, SJU held a 20-point lead at 18:38 of the second half but saw the Tribe rally to the 87-85 win

**IRON MEN**

- Backcourt mates **Lamarr Kimble** and **Jared Bynum** have racked up the minutes
- Prior to his injury, Kimble was averaging 35.8 and ranks fifth in the A-10 and 46th in the NCAA stats
- Bynum is 10th in the A-10 at 35.1 minutes per game, but that number is sure to increase with Kimble sidelined. The freshman played 40 minutes for the first time in his career in the Davidson win

**DEAN OF COACHES**

- **Phil Martelli** is in his 24th season as head coach and is the dean of the Atlantic 10's coaches. He owns an overall record of 438-318 and is SJU's all-time leader in victories
- Martelli owns a 213-168 record in Atlantic 10 play, which ranks second all-time and first among active coaches for conference wins
- His career total of 438 wins is also second all-time (to Temple's John Chaney) and the top number for active coaches in the A-10
- Martelli is one of 25 active D-1 coaches who are their schools' all-time wins leaders

**FRESH APPROACH**

- **Lamarr "Fresh" Kimble** helped the Hawks pull away at Princeton as he poured in 22 second-half points
- The captain made 8-of-12 from the field in the half, and had 10 of 13 points as SJU expanded on a three-point halftime lead, going up by 53-45
- It was the second game in which Kimble had a big second half to help the Hawks to the win; he previously scored 24 of his career-high-tying 31 points vs. UIC in the second half
- Kimble is averaging a career-best 16.3 points per game
- He has scored 20-plus points in four games this season

**WHAT BROWN CAN DO FOR YOU**

- **Charlie Brown, Jr.**, established a new career-high for the third time this year when he poured in 37 points at William & Mary
- He scored 23 in the first half, the highest single-half total of his career, hitting 11-of-17 from the field and 11-of-14 from the foul line
- His 37 points are the third most in the history of Kaplan Arena and tied the seventh highest single-game scoring total in SJU history
- Brown remains the leading scorer in the A-10 with his 19.6 average
- The last Hawk to average 20-plus points in a full season was Jameer Nelson (20.6) in 2003-04. Shavar Newkirk averaged 20.3 ppg in 2016-17, but he played only 12 games after being sidelined an injury

**THE CAPTAIN, THE HERO**

- **Lamarr Kimble** hit the game-winner with 0.4 left on the clock to lift Saint Joseph's to a 45-42 win over Loyola Chicago at The Palestra
- It was the team captain's third game-winning shot as a Hawk
- "It wasn't exactly the way we drew it up," said coach **Phil Martelli**. "But he's got a little bit of freedom, because his heart's bigger than his body."

**THREES ALL AROUND**

- **Charlie Brown, Jr.**, ranks second in the A-10 in three-point percentage (45.6) and is tied for fifth in threes made per game (2.3)
- Saint Joseph's is sixth in the A-10 in team 3-point percentage, hitting 33.3 percent, but is 13th in league games, making 26.9 percent of its long-range shots

**ALL ABOUT ANTHONY**

- **Anthony Longpré** connected on three three-pointers for a season-high 10 points against George Mason
- He followed that a career-high 11 rebounds, to go along with eight points, vs. GW, and had a team-high six rebounds at St. Bonaventure
- Longpré had another strong game on the boards at Duquesne, leading the squad with nine to go along with nine points

**TAYLOR'S THREE'S**

- Sophomore **Taylor Funk** has 114 three-pointers in the 49 games of his career thus far, and reached 100 quicker than any other Hawk. By comparison, all-time leader Langston Galloway made 75 threes in his first 37 games
- Funk set the SJU freshman record last season when he made 84 in 32 games
- He hit a career-best 6-for-7 from beyond the arc in the win over Wake Forest
- But he has struggled as of late, going 3-for-26 in the last five games

**LIFT FROM LODGE**

- **Markell Lodge** gave the Hawks a lift at Princeton, recording season-highs of nine points and 14 minutes
- Lodge had three dunks in the game, including one to start a 5-0 run with under six minutes to play, which helped seal the win
- He followed that with 13 minutes at Villanova in which he contributed five points
- Lodge had a season-high three blocks in the Loyola win and matched that with three against George Mason
- He has nine blocks in A-10 contests to tie for second in the league

**20/20**

- **Charlie Brown, Jr.** has tallied 20-plus points in seven of 16 games this season; he now has eight games of 20 points or more in 47 career games

**ON BOARD**

- **Taylor Funk** now leads the Hawks in rebounding with 5.8 in overall games and 6.2 in A-10 games. **Anthony Longpré** ranks second in conference games with 6.0 per game
- **Pierfrancesco Oliva** had been the Hawks' top rebounder for the first part of the season as he had double-figure rebounds four times, with the last two coming at William & Mary (12) and vs. UIC (13)
- Oliva also posted the first double-double of his career vs. ODU (17 pts, 14 reb)

**DEPTH CHARGES**

- The Hawks have not gotten much scoring from their bench this season and it has been a contributing factor to eight of the nine losses, as SJU's reserves have been outscored, 221-51, in those games.
- Here's the bench scoring breakdown:

- They actually held a slight edge, 11-10, at St. Bonaventure in the loss
- SJU outscored Davidson, 15-7, in the win

**SHARP SHOOTERS**

- The Hawks have shot 50 percent or better in nine of 34 halves played this year, with a high of 58.6 percent in the second half of the Monmouth win
- SJU converted more than 50 percent in both halves at Princeton, finishing the game hitting 55.0 percent

**PRODUCTIVE 20 MINUTES**

- **Lamarr Kimble's** 22-point second half at Princeton was his second 20-plus point half of the year, and the third highest of the season
- Kimble had 24 points in the second half against UIC which is highest single-half total for a Hawk this season. **Charlie Brown** scored 23 of his 37 points vs. William & Mary in the first half

**END TO END**

- The win at Princeton was the first game this season that the Hawks held the lead from start to finish. There were two ties, but SJU never let the Tigers forge ahead

**HANDOUTS**

- Saint Joseph's showed great ball movement against Wake Forest and got everyone involved as the Hawks had 20 assists on 32 baskets

**30 FOR 30**

- SJU received individual 30-point efforts in three consecutive games, as **Lamarr Kimble** netted 31 vs. West Virginia and UIC while **Charlie Brown, Jr.**, had at 37 points at William & Mary

**RALLY TOWELS**

- SJU trailed by 13 points in the second half against UIC, but rallied to post an 89-75 win; it was the largest deficit overcome for victory thus far this season

**CHECK IT OUT**

- **Pierfrancesco "Checco" Oliva** had a stellar season debut, coming off the bench to record

the first double-double of his career against ODU

- The redshirt junior had 17 points and 14 rebounds, while shooting 6-of-9 from the field
- **Phil Martelli** said that although he doesn't like labels, "Oliva is the epitome of a point-forward". The coach also revealed that Oliva deferred his starting role to sophomore **Anthony Longpré**

**KIMBLE'S KUDOS**

- **Lamarr Kimble** was named the A-10 Co-Player of the Week for Dec. 10 and the first time in his career
- He was the team's leading scorer in the Princeton and Villanova games, averaging 22.0 points, 5.0 rebounds and 4.0 assists. Kimble scored all of his team-high 22 points in the second half, and shot 8-for-12 from the field, as SJU earned the win at Princeton
- He led SJU in scoring with 22 points in a loss at #21 Villanova while adding five rebounds, four assists and a season-high three steals

**WELCOME TO THE LEAGUE**

- **Jared Bynum** was named the A-10 Rookie of the Week for Dec. 3 after averaging 20.0 points, 3.5 rebounds and 3.5 assists in the 1-1 week for the first honor of his career
- He converted 68.8 percent (11-for-16) from the field and 94.1 percent (16-of-17) from the foul line in the two games
- Bynum tied his career-high with 17 points in the win over UIC, converting 9-of-9 free throws. He also registered two assists and no turnovers for the fourth time in seven games
- He then set a new career-high with 23 points against Temple, making 7-of-9 field goals and 7-of-8 free throws, and tying his season-high with five assists

**YOU'RE A GOOD MAN, CHARLIE BROWN**

- **Charlie Brown, Jr.**, was named the Atlantic 10 Player of the Week for Nov. 19, marking the first time he has earned the league's weekly honor as an upperclassman; he was also chosen as the Big 5 Co-Player of the Week
- He averaged 23.3 points in four games, shooting 58.5 percent from the field and 54.2 percent from three-point range (18-for-22)

**CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN**

- Redshirt junior **Lamarr "Fresh" Kimble** was voted team captain for the third consecutive season, becoming the only player in SJU history to serve as captain for three years
- As a sophomore, Kimble became just the third player in Hawk history to be named a captain in his second season
- Kimble's leadership is appreciated by **Phil Martelli**: "I'm glad he's on my team and I'm glad he's in my program because whatever I

need... He's in charge of that locker room... Fresh is just legit. He's one of those guys that embraces being a Philadelphian and playing in Philadelphia.... I'm a big Fresh fan, forget the basketball. He is the epitome of a captain."

**LOOK AT LORENZO**

- **Phil Martelli** stated in the preseason that redshirt sophomore **Lorenzo Edwards** was one player who had made the biggest strides over the summer
- Edwards gave a glimpse of that improvement as he scored 11 points in 15 minutes vs. Monmouth, making 5-of-7 from the field
- He has seen action in 13 games this year and is averaging 8.8 minutes
- Edwards notched a career-high four blocks against George Mason
- He missed the GW, St. Bonaventure and Duquesne games with a shoulder injury

**THEY'RE BACK**

- Two of SJU's leading scorers from two seasons ago — **Lamarr Kimble** and **Charlie Brown, Jr.** — made their return to the court this season
- Kimble, who averaged 15.5 points per game in 2016-17, reinjured his left foot in the 2017-18 opener and missed the rest of the year
- Brown never got his 2017-18 season underway as he fractured his left wrist in the preseason, underwent surgery and was sidelined for the year. As a freshman, Brown averaged 12.8 points per game to earn All-Rookie honors

**NEW TO THE FOLD**

- The Hawks' scholarship newcomers are **Jared Bynum** (Fr.), **Troy Holston** (Gr. transfer) and **Ryan Daly** (Jr. transfer)
- Bynum, a point guard from Georgetown Prep averaged over 17 points and six assists last year. He was the IAC Player of the Year and an All-Met selection
- Holston joined the Hawks from South Florida, where he played two seasons while battling knee injuries. He received his bachelor's degree last spring and averaged 9.7 points in 2016-17. He has two years of eligibility at SJU
- Daly comes "home" to SJU, transferring from Delaware. A native of nearby Ardmore, Pa., Daly scored 1,000 points in two seasons at Delaware and earned All-CAA honors twice. SJU connections run in his family as both of his parents are alums and his late grandfather, Jim Boyle, was the Hawks' head coach from 1981 to 1990. Daly will have two years of eligibility at SJU after sitting out this season

**SEEING RED**

- SJU's roster is dotted with five players who have redshirted at least one season while on Hawk Hill. Although that number seems unusually high, it is actually tied for the fifth most in the nation. Four schools (CSU Bakersfield, Rider, UCF, Saint Mary's) lead with nine each while four schools have eight red-shirts on their active rosters
- Saint Joseph's redshirts are:
  - **Charlie Brown, Jr.** (R-So.) - missed the 2017-18 season with shoulder injury
  - **Lorenzo Edwards** (R-So.) - had shoulder surgery during this freshman year
  - **Lamarr Kimble** (R-Jr.) - reinjured his foot in the first game of 2017-18 and underwent surgery, missing all but one game
  - **Markell Lodge** (R-Sr.) - redshirted his first year to concentrate on academics
  - **Pierfrancesco Oliva** (R-Jr.) - sat out his sophomore season after having surgery to correct a chronic knee condition

**FROM THE START**

- **Jared Bynum** became the sixth freshman in six years to be in the Hawks' starting lineup on opening day
- Previous freshman starters for SJU were: **Anthony Longpré** (2017-18), **Charlie Brown** (2016-17), **Pierfrancesco Oliva** (2015-16), James Demery (2014-15) and current Atlanta Hawk DeAndre' Bembyr (2013-14)

**WISE BEYOND THEIR YEARS**

- **Phil Martelli** commented that the Hawks are an "older" team this year with five players who have redshirted previous seasons and one graduate student (**Troy Holston**)
- The average age of the Hawks' scholarship players is 21 years old
- **Markell Lodge** and Holston are both 23, while **Pierfrancesco Oliva** and **Lamarr Kimble** are each 22 years old
- The following are the Hawks' "redshirts" with their respective seasons on campus:
  - **Markell Lodge** (5th)
  - **Pierfrancesco Oliva** (4th)
  - **Lamarr Kimble** (4th)
  - **Lorenzo Edwards** (3rd)
  - **Charlie Brown** (3rd)

• Holston is in his first season at SJU after transferring from South Florida. He played two seasons with the Bulls while battling knee injuries

**PICKING THE HAWKS**

- Saint Joseph's was picked second in the A-10 Preseason Poll, which is the highest for the Hawks since the 2012-13, when they were tabbed first
- Last year's squad was picked third in the poll, and despite two key injuries, finished fourth in the league and reached the semifinals while posting a 16-16 overall record

- **Lamarr Kimble** and **Charlie Brown, Jr.**, were each named to the 2018-19 Atlantic 10 Preseason All-Conference Third Team

**STRONG FINISH**

- Despite facing its second straight season with key injuries in 2017-18, the Hawks came on strong at the end of the year and finished with a 16-16 record
- SJU closed out the regular season winning three straight and six of its last seven to finish in fourth place with a 10-8 record
- The Hawks defeated George Mason in the A-10 Quarterfinals but were edged by top-seeded Rhode Island, 90-87, in the semifinals

**HONORING THE COACH**

- The Hawks are wearing a patch on their uniforms with "McK" to honor former coach Jack McKinney, who passed away in September
- McKinney was head coach at Saint Joseph's for eight seasons, from 1966 to 1974. He compiled a 144-77 record and owns the third best all-time winning percentage (65.2 pct) among SJU coaches
- McKinney took the Hawks to postseason play five times in his eight years, which included four NCAA Tournament appearances
- He went on to coach in the NBA, although a serious accident cut short his season with the Lakers in 1979. He rebounded to earn NBA Coach of the Year honors with the Indiana Pacers in 1981

**FUTURE HAWKS**

- Saint Joseph's signed two standouts to national letters of intent during the early signing period - Hakim Hart and Kenan Sarvan
- Hart, a 6-5, 190-pound, swingman from Roman Catholic High School in Philadelphia, averaged 15.1 points per game last season and earned All-Catholic League honors. He helped Roman win the 2018 Philadelphia Catholic League championship and the 2018 PIAA 6A State Championship
- Sarvan is a 6-9, 220-pound forward originally from Holland and currently attending Bishop Sullivan Catholic High School in Virginia Beach. As a junior, he averaged 14.6 points and 7.8 rebounds for the Crusaders

**STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE**

- SJU has seven opponents on its schedule which reached last year's NCAA Tournament - Villanova, Loyola Chicago, West Virginia, Davidson, St. Bonaventure, Penn and Rhode Island

**HOME AT HAGAN**

- This marks the 10th season of the Hawks' home, Hagan Arena, after Alumni Memorial Fieldhouse underwent a renovation and expansion in 2008-09

- The Hawks are happy about the return to the Barclays Center for the A-10 Championship as the arena has been good to them in the past. Saint Joseph's last two Atlantic 10 titles have been won on that court, in 2014 and 2016

**CRADLE OF COACHES**

- The Saint Joseph's coaching connection is an impressive one. A total of seven SJU graduates have gone on to become head coaches in the NBA, and SJU is tied with Illinois for second on the list of universities with alums that have served as NBA head coaches. Indiana tops the list with 11 graduates.

## PHIL MARTELLI Head Coach 24th Season - 438-318

With the 2018-19 season marking his 24th as the head basketball coach at Saint Joseph's, **Phil Martelli** has built a program that is consistently one of the top in the conference, a perennial postseason participant and a key player on the national scene. In doing so, he has earned his place among the top coaches in the school's storied history and is one of the more respected coaches in the game.

Martelli is the Hawks' all-time leader in career victories with a mark of 438-318. Setting the school record for wins in a season (30) in 2004, Martelli has guided SJU to 20 or more victories nine times in his 23 previous seasons, which is the most for any Hawks' coach. His record of 213-168 in Atlantic 10 play is the most conference wins for any active coach and ranks second all-time in the league.

**Martelli Highlights:**

- He has taken SJU to the postseason in four of the last seven years, and 13 times in the 23 seasons previous to this one, while winning three Atlantic 10 Championships (1997, 2014, 2016)
- Martelli's 18 postseason wins (7 NCAA, 11 NIT) are the most in school history
- Despite injuries to two key players, his 2017-18 squad won seven of its last nine games, to finish fourth in the Atlantic 10 and reach the conference semifinals
- His 2015-16 team compiled a 28-8 record for the second-most victories for a Hawk team, won its second Atlantic 10 title in three seasons and advanced to the NCAA Second Round for the first time since 2004
- Four of his players have been named the Atlantic 10 Player of the Year, with the most recent being DeAndre' Bemby in 2015-16
- In 2013-14, his veteran team turned in one of the more memorable seasons in school history, adding another A-10 Championship to his résumé as SJU went 24-10 and reached the NCAA Tournament for the sixth time under Martelli, falling to eventual national champion Connecticut in overtime
- Seven players have reached the NBA, including first round draft picks DeAndre' Bemby (2016), Jameer Nelson (2004) and Delonte West (2004) and a second-round selection, Ahmad Nivins (2009). Dwayne Jones and Ronald Roberts, Jr. had NBA stints while undrafted free agent Langston Galloway earned All-Rookie Second Team honors with the New York Knicks in 2015. Galloway (Detroit) and Bemby (Atlanta) are currently playing in the NBA
- In 2003-04, he guided a squad that became the most compelling story in college basketball - the Hawks went undefeated in the regular season, were the top-ranked team in the nation and earned the school's first-ever number-one seed in the NCAA Tournament, advancing to the Elite Eight
- Joined with Jameer Nelson to sweep the National Coach and Player of the Year awards in 2004, marking one of the few times in history that the top player and coach were from the same school
- Current member of the NCAA Division I Basketball Oversight Committee; previously served the game as a Past President of the NABC's Board of Directors, and the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Ethics Coalition
- Is very involved with Coaches vs. Cancer, is the past chair of the National Council, and the co-chair of the Philadelphia chapter, which is one of the largest fundraising groups in this effort in the nation
- Was the co-recipient of the Circle of Honor Award given by the American Cancer Society in 2017, honored along with Temple's Fran Dunphy
- Has spent a total of 34 years with the Hawks' program, serving as an assistant coach for 10 years prior to attaining the top job in July, 1995

## THE HAWK

One of the most famous mascots in college sports, the Saint Joseph's Hawk is in its 63rd year in 2018-19.

The Hawk is best known for staying in constant motion by flapping its wings throughout every basketball game and representing the Saint Joseph's motto, "The Hawk Will Never Die."

The idea for the Hawk as a mascot was originated by Jim Brennan during the 1954-55 season. Brennan, an ex-Marine and SJU cheerleader, at first wanted to secure an actual hawk, but later switched to the costume idea. The student government raised the 120 dollars needed to buy the initial costume, which Brennan donned for three years. He made his debut as the Hawk on January 4, 1956, a 69-56 win over La Salle at the Palestra. The Hawk has not missed a men's basketball game since that first season.

In addition to the constant flapping, the Hawk is also recognized by its "flying" in figure eights around the court during timeouts. The constant motion, coupled with the scrappy play of the University's athletic teams, helped to spawn the school's familiar slogan "The Hawk Will Never Die!" A few years ago, ESPN used a "flap-o-meter" on the national telecast of a Saint Joseph's game to estimate that the Hawk flaps its wings 3,500 times during a regulation game.

The Hawk is unique because it is one of the few mascots in the nation that travels to every game, and the student who holds the position gains a tuition scholarship. The student, who is selected through an interview process during the previous spring semester, also serves as a team manager for the men's basketball team and travels with the squad.

**Domenic Godshall** is serving as the Saint Joseph's University Hawk mascot for the 2018-19 season, becoming the 39th student to represent the University in this role. He is a senior sports marketing major from Lititz, Pa.

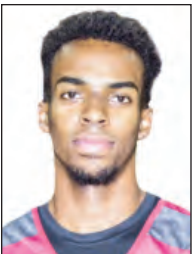

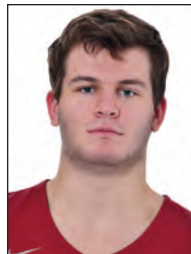
